he had his title changed to emperor. War resumed after a new coalition was formed against France. In 1805 the British destroyed French naval power in the Battle of Trafalgar.

Sir William became ill and died in 1803 leaving Emma an annuity of £800. In 1805 the great love of her life, Nelson, was killed at the Battle of Trafalgar. She was inconsolable, as she was not allowed to attend Nelson's funeral. She was now without any 'protectors' and her looks began to fade.

Constable is famous for his landscapes, which are mostly of the Suffolk countryside, where he was born and lived. Description of flag: The flag of France, also called the "Tricolour", was readopted in July of 1830. It consists of three equal vertical stripes of blue (left or hoist side), white (middle), and red (right). Sometimes the three colors are said to represent the three parts of the French motto: liberty (blue), equality (white), and fraternity (red).
